1. To consider and act upon the 2012-2013 fiscal year budget of the Board of Selectmen in the amount of \$12,816,866 as recommended by the Board of Finance.
2. To consider and act upon the 2012-2013 fiscal year budget of the Board of Education in the amount of \$37,547,970 as recommended by the Board of Finance.
3. To adjourn said Special Budget Meeting, pursuant to Section 7-344 of the Connecticut State Statutes and the Colchester Town Charter Sections C-1002 and C-1101, for a Referendum vote on Tuesday, June 12, 2012 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to be held at the Colchester Town Hall, 127 Norwich Ave., Colchester, CT.
4. Any other business to come before said meeting.
