

Absentee Ballots for the **Board of Education Budget Referendum on June 23, 2015** are available in the Town Clerk's Office starting Friday **June 12, 2015**.

Absentee Ballot Instructions:

1. Fill out an application for an absentee ballot. You may obtain an application in the Town Clerk's Office.
2. After we receive the completed application you will be given an absentee ballot.
Timeframe before the Referendum **does not** allow for mailing the ballot to you
3. We must receive the filled out ballot enclosed in the provided envelopes by:
 - a. If delivered in person it must be delivered to the Town Clerk's Office no later than the Monday before the referendum at 4:30 pm.
 - b. If delivered by a qualified designee* it must be delivered by the end of polls on the day of the referendum.
 - c. If delivered by mail it must be received no later the day of the referendum.

If you have any questions or to see if you qualify to vote absentee please contact the Town Clerk's Office at 860-537-7215

*A designee is:

- A person caring for you
- A member of your family
- A police officer in this municipality
- A Registrar of Voters or Deputy Registrar of Voters in this municipality
