

Absentee Ballots for the Municipal Election on November 3, 2015 are available in the Town Clerk's Office from Friday, October 2, 2015 until November 2, 2015

Absentee Ballot instructions:

1. Fill out an application for an absentee ballot. You may obtain an application in the Town Clerk's Office or online at colchesterct.gov, Departments, Town Clerk, Forms. This will link you directly to the Secretary of the States website where you can fill out a downloadable form. You must be a current Colchester Voter at the time of the application.
2. After we receive the completed application you will be given an absentee ballot to fill out.
 - a) If you apply in person you can fill out the ballot at that time or take it with you to return within the specified period.
3. We must receive the fully filled out ballot and enclosed envelopes by:
 - a) If delivered in person it must be delivered to the Town Clerk no later than the Monday before Election Day at 4:30PM.
 - b) If delivered in person by a family member, or qualified designee*, it must reach the Town Clerk's office by the end of polls on Election Day.
 - c) If delivered by mail it must be received no later than 4:30PM on Election Day.
