AFFIDAVIT FOR ANTIQUE, RARE OR SPECIAL INTEREST MOTOR VEHICLES AS DEFINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH C.G.S. SECTION 14-1(3), TO BE ASSESSED FOR NOT MORE THAN \$500.

Vehicles, registered or non-registered, 20 years or older that are defined as an antique, rare or special interest motor vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes Section 12-71(b) and Section 14-1(3), shall not be assessed more than \$500.

Definition. Sec. 14-1 (3)

"Antique, rare or special interest motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle twenty years or older which is being preserved because of historic interest and which is not altered or modified from the original manufacturer's specifications.

Sec. 12-71 (b)

"Except as otherwise provided by the general statutes, property subject to this section shall be valued at the same percentage of its then actual valuation as the assessors have determined with respect to the listing of real estate for the same year, except that any antique, rare or special interest motor vehicle, as defined in section 14-1, shall be assessed at a value of not more than five hundred dollars. The owner of such antique, rare or special interest motor vehicle may be required by the assessors to provide reasonable documentation that such motor vehicle is an antique, rare or special interest motor vehicle, provided any motor vehicle for which special number plates have been issued pursuant to section 14-20 shall not be required to provide any such documentation..."
