Mark Reynolds, representing the applicant, detailed the application to the commission and provided a series of slides indicating the proposed activities. He explained the soil scientist hired for the project, is no longer in business. A new soil scientist has been hired and is working to prepare an evaluation of the wetland and the proposed activity. Mr. Reynolds explained he has been working on a report on the drainage of the site. He explained that he intends to complete the remaining items and submit for the next meeting in February.

A. Farm and Forest Land Presentation Program

Jay Gigliotti explained the Board of Selectmen have decided to create an Ad Hoc committee to explore the option for the Town develop a program where developments rights could be purchased from farm or forest land owners by the town. The goal of the program would be to have more options available to the town to preserve land and farms. The Board of Selectmen are requesting a representative from the Board of Selectmen, Board of Finance, Planning & Zoning Commission, Conservation Commission, Open Space Advisory Committee, Agriculture Commission and the Land Trust, be selected and attend the Ad Hoc Committee meetings.

Leslie Curtis, of the Colchester Agriculture Commission, was present and discussed the proposed Farm & Forest Preservation program.

The commission discussed the potential representatives to the Ad Hoc committee. Mike Rogers was selected to represent the Conservation Commission with Michelle Kosmo as an alternate.

I. ENFORCEMENT

1. Show Cause Hearing - 956 Middletown Road

M. Rogers inspected the property on 1/5/21 and provided a report of his observations. M. Rogers reviewed his observations and report with the commission. The commission discussed the steps moving forward. It was determined the work that was conducted was in need of a Wetlands Administrative Permit. If an administrative permit is issued, the commission could then release the Cease & Desist order. The applicant's representation stated he would like to discuss the permit with his clients and would get back to staff.
