A. North Pond Subdivision - Preliminary Discussion

J Gigliotti reported this was a preliminary discussion for a 37 lot subdivision on Windham Avenue, just North of Cousins Road. The property is 150 acres. It includes several wetland systems and a large pond. The majority of the lot is wooded and a wetlands GIS map was reviewed of the property.

Mark Reynolds, Civil Engineer, Reynolds Engineering Services, presented the commission with a slide presentation displaying the property being discussed. The wetland and crossing on the site was discussed. There was a discussion on the proposed Open Space designation and E&S Measures during construction was discussed.

The Commission would like to see both the 75' and 100' (wetland & watercourse) setbacks around the pond shown on the plans. Runoff from lawn fertilizer and a maintenance plan for the pond was also discussed.

I. ENFORCEMENT-

A. 27 Red Schoolhouse Road

In November 2018 the commission made a declaratory ruling allowing the property owner to remove 4-5 trees. An email complaint was received alleging that natural habitat in wetland areas was being destroyed. Upon a site visit to the property staff confirmed activity is taking place in the upland review area. The Conservation Commission directed staff to send the homeowner a notice of violation and request their presence at the next regular scheduled meeting to discuss corrective actions.
