

COVID-19 VACCINE ACCESS FOR THOSE 75 AND OLDER

**If you are 75 years of age or older,
you are currently eligible
to receive a COVID-19 vaccine.**



It will take time for everyone who is eligible to receive the vaccine.
Your available options for receiving vaccine are outlined below

From your medical provider

If you have already heard from your medical provider about receiving the vaccine, you do not need to do anything else.

Please, do not reach out to your doctor or medical provider about the vaccine if they have not contacted you.

Schedule an appointment at a vaccination clinic
