

Status of Town Services and Departments

UPDATED March 25th *Please note – Town Hall Departments are CLOSED to the Public*****

Colchester Public Schools

- Schools are closed at least until March 31st
- Meals for students are being provided at Bacon Academy. If you cannot travel to pick up your meals, please contact the Board of Education through their website.

Senior Center

- Colchester closed its senior center, effective Monday, March 16th. Staff continue to report.
- All programs, events and trips have been cancelled, for the next two weeks.
- Community Cafe meals are delivered as frozen individual meals for those who regularly dine at the senior center and are dependent upon senior transportation, per TVCCA guidelines.
- Meals on Wheels deliveries occur Tuesday-Friday. TVCCA did reopen intakes for new MOW clients during this time. Procedures no longer allow them to enter the home, but instead arrive, knock on the door and leave meal at the door and step back 6 feet for a wellness check.
- For those who relied on the Community Café for lunch, they are getting deliveries of 5 frozen meals once a week.
- We offer transportation services for “critical errands” with only 3 passengers at a time and disinfection occurring after each ride. Critical errands are defined as groceries, pharmacy and banking errands.
- Please feel free to call in to the Colchester Senior Center at 860-537-3911 during our regular business hours of 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, if there is any way that we can be of assistance, by phone.

Cragin Library

- Library is closed until further notice.
- Staff continue to report.
- We offer access to e-books, e-audiobooks, streaming video, test preparation, and other online resources to any Colchester resident with an active library card.
- No overdue fines will accrue. No materials will be due while the Library is closed.
- You can call the library to get an electronic library card to access electronic resources.
- “Libby” is an app available with your electronic library card.

Transfer Station

- Transfer Station is running normal hours at this time. Tuesday and Saturday 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- We do want to decrease potential exposure to the Town worker so you will see them wearing gloves. You will also be directed to wait so as to limit the amount of people on the transfer/pad at the top. This will likely increase the wait time in line and we feel it is necessary.
