a. Town Planner Report

Mr. Bordeaux stated that the C-TIP Application for ARK Distillery LLC was unanimously approved at the Town Meeting on March 16, 2022. He also said that the Tax Abatement Agreement was signed by the First Selectman and Meredith Shay, owner of InCord for the recently approved C-TIP. Mr. Bordeaux stated that he anticipates NCT Friction Welding Inc to be ready to open soon.

Mr. Bordeaux discussed the status of the Town Green Improvement project and the Lebanon Avenue Sidewalk Extension project. The cost and accessibility of certain materials required for the two projects were causing complications and delays.

6. Old Business

a. ARPA and Economic Development discussion per letter from Planning Director The Commission discussed undertaking additional functions beyond facilitating the C-TIP program. The concept of an Economic Development Strategy and a Marketing and Branding

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Strategy was discussed. The Commission requested that staff generate a project description that could be considered by the Board of Selectman, and the Commission volunteered to spend some time researching and learning more about comparable undertakings in other municipalities.
