Who We Are & What We Do

The Colchester Ethics Commission is charged with administering the Town's Code of Ethics. The Commission receives complaints about suspected violations of the Ethics Code, holds fact-gathering hearings and issues opinions about whether the Code has been violated. The Commission has bi-monthly meetings and meets as needed to address pending complaints and requests for advisory opinions.

The five-member Commission is made up of town residents who are each appointed to the Commission by the Board of Selectmen. Other than a strong sense of fair-mindedness and a willingness to uphold the Code, there are no special qualifications to serve on the commission.
