Suggestions for social activities that would meet with the safety protocols such as outdoor movie night, a random hike, new and different ways to socialize, ways to reduce stress and anxiety and to engage Social Services, schools, Park & Recreation and mental health professionals to develop ideas. Community activities could be associated with the Farmers Market and the Community Market.
