- 6. Project Manager update and potential action: J. Butkus and K. Jackson participated in a conference call with Fuss & O'Neill to discuss the pros and cons of retesting of samples for possible PCBs. Drawing markups will be provided to members showing recommended areas to test.

- Tecton continues to look at ways to address open ceiling areas.

- S. Melingonis researched the fans being used in the gym but could not find anything specifically regarding what is covered under the warranty. A. Tarnowski suggested obtaining a letter from the manufacturer stating that the fans being hit by balls will not void the warranty.
- Five schemes for dumpster enclosures were looked at. P. Picard requested that tractor trailers have a direct path to the loading dock. Scheme 3b., swapping dock and dumpster locations, was the preferred choice.
