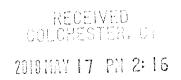

- 7. Discussion and potential action on Fuss & O'Neill Proposal for Hazardous Building Materials Construction Administration/Monitoring Services, Phase 3 Summer 2018: A. Tarnowski motioned to approve Fuss & O'Neill proposal for hazardous building materials construction administration and project monitoring services associated with Phase 3 of the William J. Johnston Middle School Renovation Project in an amount not to exceed \$49,019.29, seconded by L. Goodwin. Vote was unanimous. MOTION CARRIED.

8. Architect update and potential action:

- Bid materials were released today.
- Tecton still working on options and costs for hiding piping and ductwork.
- The Committee viewed options for brick staining.

9. Construction Manager update and potential action:

- G. Kotait distributed O&G Monthly Progress Report No. 13 through April 2018.
- Summary Data and Project Commentary were reviewed.
- Members discussed sod and irrigation. It was agreed that sod would not be maintained to the
 degree in which it needs to be and is not reimbursable. Irrigation is reimbursable but
 members are undecided as if that is an area in which money should be spent. Chairman Tyler
 reminded members that the Committee was previously approached by youth baseball league
 regarding a field that was lost in design of the field space.
