7. Approval of Invoices:

a. Construction Group Solutions: J. Ruiz motioned to approve paying CSG invoice #3, in the amount of \$2,798.65 for services provided through June 30th, seconded by M. Mlodzinski. All members voted in favor. **MOTION CARRIED.**

8. Referendum Schedule:

Discussion with First Selectman Bylone and Senator Needleman - The town budget is slated for referendum on September 21st. The project referendum could be moved to the same date as the budget vote. Senator Needleman, along with State Representatives Irene Haines and Brian Smith, put forward an application to the State Bonding Commission to obtain a grant in the amount of approximately \$3 million. Senator Needleman explained that while it has been requested he does not know when it will be placed on the agenda but is hoping for September. He cannot guarantee the funding but he does feel strongly that it has a good possibility of passing. The members discussed what they saw as pros and cons of putting off the project referendum or combining it with the budget vote. There was consensus among members to postpone setting a new referendum date until the status of the funding is known.

9. Public Information Sub-committee Report

a. Informational Town Meeting – Agenda and Presentations: Chairman Tarnowski continues to receive positive feedback during presentations. The subcommittee will meet to discuss how to move forward. There needs to be a clear message that the vote has only been delayed and was done so in the best interest of the taxpayers.
