It is with great pride and honor that I inform the citizens of Colchester that on Thursday evening February 21st, the Board of Selectmen voted unanimously to include the proposed paramedic program into the upcoming budget plan (2019/2020). This decision was the result of a presentation to a Joint Board Meeting (Board of Selectman & Board of Finance) given on Wednesday night February 20th, where data was presented on how a *fire department based paramedic program* will benefit Colchester residents in need of emergency medical care. Information was also presented on how the cost of the CFD providing advanced life support can be offset with additional revenue generation, and how adding advanced life support to the services already provided by the Colchester Fire Department, can potentially reduce financial liability for patients receiving this care.

Over the upcoming days and weeks, we will be scheduling information sessions throughout the community to share information and answer questions concerning the proposed program.
