Due to Covid 19, customers were required to wear masks. Customers were limited to one at a time into the stand. Those not willing to wear masks or wait their turn left and do not return for the summer or fall. This resulted in a loss of income estimated at \$5,500.00 to \$7,500.00

Project Description:

We are currently experiencing a supply shortage. We want to use the funds to order seeds and prepare for the season ahead. We will be buying more inventory; we will need to order fertilizer and spray (for certain crops to prevent weeds.)

The negative impact of Covid:

Many factors played into how Covid negatively impacted the farm and the stand. There was a reduction in product by 50%. Certain crops we plant have to be sprayed for weeds. The spray we use to reduce/prevent weeds is either unavailable, or we receive less spray than we order due to supply chain shortages. The next problem is that the weeds begin to overcrowd the produce. If our seeds don't grow or produce due to the weeds drowning out the product, this results in a poor yield.

We buy a lot of black mulch plastic, and we put this between the rows to prevent weeds from choking out the crops. Inflation plays a factor when the quantity is less than before on anything. More often than not, we would receive less than we ordered. The distributors have been shortening orders to accommodate all their clients. They provide for due to their lack of supply or not wanting to operate on first-come, first-served bases. The rations from distributors or unfulfilled orders hurt my business because my needs are not being met for inventory to have a successful yield.

Some hybrid seeds are not available. The problem with using seeds of lesser quality is that you get mongrels that are not great a product.

When there is a limited supply of the inventory we need, running a time-sensitive business is even more difficult.

There was also a lack of help. We did not have the staff needed. In years past, they used to come to the farm and wanted to work. Now They don't want to work due to the uncertainty of the pandemic when it first started. The issue became wearing the mask, and no one wanted to wear a mask when they were working outside.

Customers were frustrated with the mask policies as well. They got irritated and impatient if they had to wait in line. It was only one person at the store time regulars who would come for years have never come back since the pandemic and never return for the rest of the season. An average consumer would spend \$25 per person per month, and about 35 regulars never came back last season.

The positive impact this would have on the Community:

We provide top-quality vegetables for all people. There is a convenience factor of having the opportunity to pick fresh-picked vegetables.

We would have ample supplies of vegetables for our Community to buy and pick

What would happen without the funds?

We are a small family-owned business not receiving the arpa.

We can't afford to take another hit. Last year's weather was the worst we've seen yet. If temperatures drop, it's a complete loss of crops, and once you lose a crop, you can't make it up until the following season. There is a tight window to grow the crops and bring our best crops to the stand.

We plant the seeds in April.

And the stand opens on June 10th.

But with no product or limited product to bring to the stands, we can't set ourselves up for the next business year.

We will need to order seeds, black mulch plastic, and diesel into the trackers and rototiller. Please see invoices for pricing on the material.

Spring & Early Summer

Lost 70-80% of first 3 batches of Sweet Corn due to extreme cold and rain and bird damaging ears of Corn

Loss of Melons, Watermelons Cucumbers, Tomatoes during the flooding rainstorm in early summer

Lost 50% of Hay crop due to extreme cloudy and wet days

Loss of 50%-60% of Pumpkins Gourds and Winter Squash due to wet and humid conditions in the fall season

Big increase in expenses - Fertilizer, materials, supplies, Fuel, parts + labor on machinery

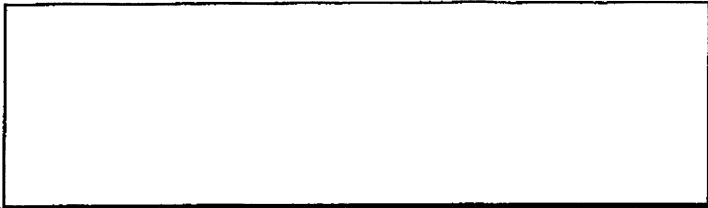

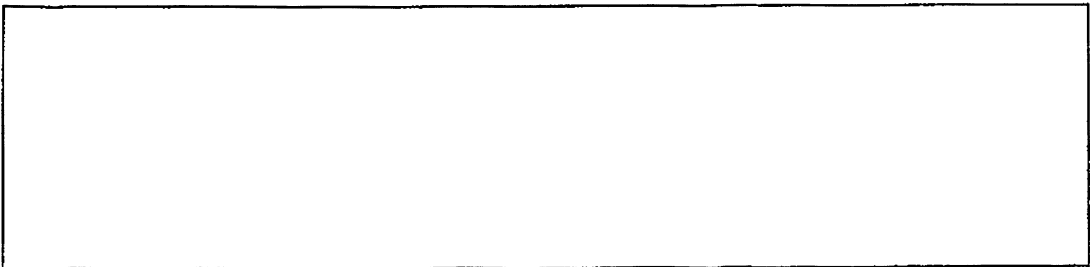

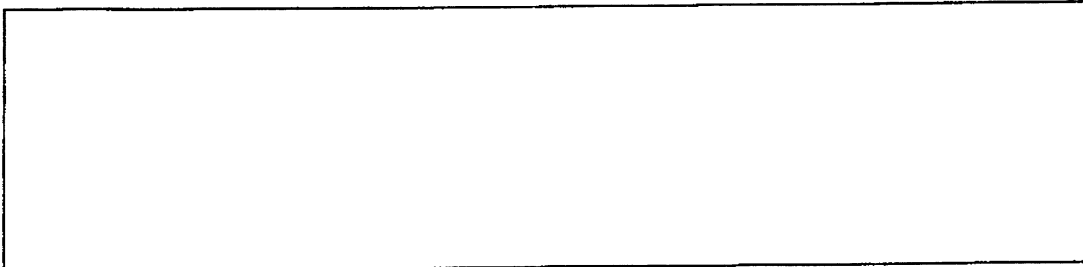
