To: Colchester First Selectman and Board of Selectmen;

My name is Joanne Rose. I was most recently a member of the Town of Colchester ad hoc Diversity and Inclusion Committee. I am writing this as a letter of concern in response to the Proclamation issued by the Colchester First Selectman, Andreas Bisbikos, on November 15, 2021. Please add this to the minutes of the Board of Selectmen meeting on November 18, 2021.

It may be easiest to submit my concerns by utilizing the wording in the 11/15/2021 Proclamation;

1. "Unfairly and falsely came to assert that racism is a public health crisis affecting our town"

Response: A statement directly from the CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention) "Racism; both interpersonal and structural - negatively affects the mental and physical health of millions of people, preventing them from attaining their highest level of health, and consequently affecting the health of our nation. A growing body of research shows that centuries of racism in this country has had a profound and negative impact on communities of color. The impact is pervasive and deeply embedded in our society- affecting where one lives, learns, works, worships and plays, creating inequities in access to a range of social and economic benefits- such as housing, education, wealth, and employment. These conditions - often referred to as "social determinants of health" are key drivers of health inequities within communities of color, placing those within these populations at greater risk for poor health outcomes. The data show that racial and ethnic minority groups, throughout the United States, experience higher rates of illness and death across a wide range of health conditions, including diabetes, hypertension, obesity, asthma, and heart disease, when compared to their White counterparts. Additionally, the life expectancy of non-Hispanic/Black Americans is four years lower than that of White Americans...."

As our town does include a population of individuals who are BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Color) this public health crisis does affect our town.

2. "...proclamation insinuated that the town of Colchester is a racist community or one where racism has been allowed to cultivate to the point where it is deemed a public health crisis - this is without facts or data to back said assertion."

Response: In no part of the previously issued Proclamation issued by the Colchester First Selectman does it say that "Colchester is a racist community". Again, verifiable, valid data shows that racism within the United States negatively impacts the health of not only individuals who identify as BIPOC, but our nation as a whole.

3. "On July 15th, 2021, the Ad Hoc Committee on Diversity and Inclusion findings were presented to the board of Selectmen and concluded that institutionalized racism does not exist in Colchester."

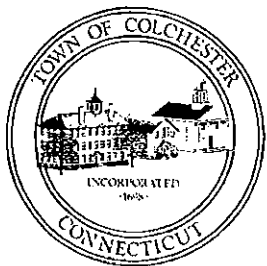
Response: I am perplexed by this statement. As a member of said ad hoc committee, I would never suppose to endorse such a broad statement. The ad hoc committee interviewed the Town of Colchester; Human Resource Director, Town Planner, Police Commissioner and Senior Center Director. After interviewing each person, the ad hoc committee included statements and recommendations made by each individual and were included in the "charge" issued by the ad hoc committee.

4." ...review of HR policies, and practices at town hall, reaching out to diverse communities, ensuring that all employees go through sensitivity training, and meeting our state goals on affordable housing".

Response; I agree with this endeavor. Fortunately, the new Commission CORE will also be on board.

Lastly, I will not go point by point through the remainder of the Proclamation issued 11/15/2021. I do feel that as a whole, it minimizes individual concerns expressed by members of the Colchester community.

The Town has done a great job with COVID, ahead in vaccinations and down in the number of cases due to cooperation of the community.

There is \$4.6 Million coming in from ARPA

The infrastructure bill passed at the Federal level which means there will be funds coming to the state and ultimately Colchester.

Bloom Energy flipped the switch and that means increased revenue coming to the town.

The construction on Town Green will be beginning soon.

They will begin laying the main irrigation pipe at RecPlex and then the fields R1 and R2 will get irrigated from ARPA funding before spring sports.

The street scape project on Lebanon Ave. will run sidewalks from North Woods to Center of Town.

The basketball court will be redone soon.

The roof will be replaced soon at the Youth Center.

The demolition on both Mill and Westchester Ave, will be taking place soon. Both houses were used by the Firefighters for training.

Norton Park Phase one remediation will be done soon.

Jack's Chevrolet has cleared all hurdles and has gotten a "clear bill of health" from the state, and they hope to have a purchaser of that property in the next coming months.





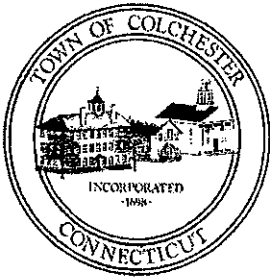

Dear Municipal CEO:

This is a reminder that municipalities must register to receive their sign-on packet for the two opioids settlements.

The website to register is <https://nationalopioidsettlement.com/>. In order to register, you will need your municipality's unique registration code. If you are unable to locate the code, please contact Mike Muszynski (mmuszynski@ccm-ct.org).

The deadline to join the settlement is January 2, 2022. It is important that you register as with more municipalities signing to the settlement will result in more money in the earlier years and reduces the chances of losing money in later years if circumstances change. This is especially true for the Johnson and Johnson settlement, because if enough eligible municipalities participate by January 2nd, the payments for years 1-4 could be accelerated significantly.

As mentioned previously, CCM has convened a Special Committee on Opioids Settlement. The Committee, which is chaired by Mayor Neil O'Leary, will develop guidance to towns and cities on the receipt and dissemination of funds through the National Opioids Settlement, which Connecticut and many municipalities were a party to. The Committee will be working directly with Attorney General William Tong to facilitate an efficient process and maximize participation among municipalities.

RE: Evaluation & Award of RFP/Q for Affordable Housing Plan

The Town of Colchester Planning and Zoning Department was awarded the Affordable Housing Plan Technical Assistance Grant by the State Department of Housing in the amount of \$15,000. The grant will fund consultant services associated with the development of an Affordable Housing Plan (the Plan) in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes 8-30j. The period of the award is from September 1, 2021 to October 31, 2022.

In response to the Request for Proposals to develop the Plan, the Town of Colchester received two (2) proposals from qualified planning consulting groups: Goman+York Property Advisors and SLR International Corporation (SLR) (formerly Milone & MacBroom, Inc.). Each proposal will be led by a project manager that is a certified planner with the American Planning Association. Both groups have produced Affordable Housing Plans for multiple towns in Connecticut and utilize a comparable approach that reflects guidance provided by the Connecticut Department of Housing. With the limited available budget of \$15,000, both groups have demonstrated their ability to satisfy the requirements of the General Statutes and make meaningful recommendations to improve access to affordable housing in CT municipalities. While the proposals have only limited differences, the proposal from SLR includes the use of the ArcGIS StoryMap platform to provide a dynamic and integrated “home base” for the project. StoryMaps provides the opportunity to solicit feedback as well as educate residents. In the absence of a survey (which neither proposal includes) SLR’s proposal stands out in this area. This additional layer of potential access for public feedback complements the two (2) public info/input sessions and one final report to the legislative body proposed by both respondents.

After speaking with the references provided by SLR, the StoryMaps tool provides an added level of community engagement that was a big part of the reason that the communities that chose to work with SLR, did so.

After reviewing both proposals with department staff and reviewing the reference material provided by the planning consultants, I recommend the Board award the project to SLR International Corporation.


