Good evening Board of Selectman members,

I want to express my dismay to learn that the Board of Selectman meeting will be held in-person tonight and presumably for the foreseeable future. I sent a similar letter to the BOF last night.

As COVID rates rapidly escalate and are currently at their highest since January 2021, I ask that the First Selectman reconsider his decision in consultation with the Chatham Health Department and the BOS at large. Not only is this decision ill-timed, it also reduces access to and transparency into the BOS meetings at the start of a new term, the upcoming budget season, and many critical policy decisions. I would be interested to know how the participation at BOS meetings has changed since moving to a virtual format, and suspect it has only grown over the past 20 months.

By and large, the state and country are operating in a hybrid environment. Until Town Hall procures the right technology to broadcast and conduct meetings in a hybrid manner, I would request that the process of virtual meetings continue for health, safety and access for all residents.

Tonight is a step backwards for Colchester and again, I ask that you reconsider.

  - D. Tax Collector' refunds

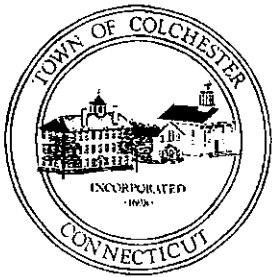

7. C-TIP TAX ABATEMENT FOR INCORD: M. Bordeaux, Town Planner and Bruce Goldstein, Chairman of the Economic Development Commission presented to the board a recommendation from the EDC for an application from a business in town, InCord. A. Bisbikos made a motion to support the C-TIP abatement for InCord. D. Bates seconded. Motion carried 4-0. R. Coyle amended motion recommended C-TIP should be brought before the legislative body of the town for the town meeting 12/16/2021 at 6:30 p.m. in town hall. D. Bates seconded. Carried 4-0.
8. SENIOR CENTER BUILDING COMMITTEE RECOMMENDED MOTIONS: T. Tarnowski spoke about referendum passing. Need BOS to approve recommendations to proceed to next step. R. Coyle moved to approved schematic design. A. Bisbikos seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
- R. Coyle motioned to authorize design and development phase. D. Turner seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
- R. Coyle motioned to authorize construction of document phase. D. Turner seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
- R. Coyle motioned to authorize Construction Solutions Group – Phase 1 services as being complete and satisfactory of contract. D. Turner seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Bisbikos will not mandate but wants to leave the boards to do this at their discretion but would agree to zoom meetings for those that feel more comfortable doing it this way. Participants of the board are allowed to zoom in. R. Coyle referred to sign about masks and the concern of people are unvaccinated not wearing masks.

Matt,

As discussed, I believe the ordinance, as currently drafted, is sufficient to preclude a preservation entity that receives Town Contributions from using such Town funds for salaries, overhead, etc. An appropriate place to flesh out these concepts would be in the contract between the Town and the preservation entity required per Section 92-5 of the ordinance.

However, if you would like to reinforce these concepts in the ordinance itself, I have two suggestions:

1. At the end of Section 92-1.B, add the following sentence: "By way of clarity, a preservation entity shall not use Town contributions for any other expenses or costs, including, but not limited to, salaries, overhead, education programs or enforcement, regardless of whether such expenses or costs relate to the subject property."

## Chapter 92

### OPEN SPACE PRESERVATION FUND

#### § 92-1. Purpose.

Pursuant to the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 7-148(c)(2)(K), the Town of Colchester (the Town) does hereby create a special fund, which fund shall be known as the "Open Space Preservation Fund" (the fund), and which fund shall not lapse at the end of the municipal fiscal year. The fund's purposes shall be ~~the preservation of open space~~:

A. The preservation of open space by the Town or the acquisition by the Town of land or interests in land for open space ~~or for recreational or agricultural purposes (the "open space purposes")~~ purposes (the Town acquisitions), and

B. For contributions (the Town contributions) to a governmental body or a charitable corporation or trust whose purposes include open space purposes (a preservation entity), which Town contributions shall be for such preservation entity's pre-acquisition costs, such as appraisals and other due diligence, closing costs, and/or for a portion of the acquisition costs of land or interests in land for open space purposes.

The term "open space purposes" as used in this chapter shall mean the preservation of land for open space, recreational or agricultural purposes.

#### § 92-2. Sources of funding, investments, and limitation on fund use.

A. In addition to such sums as may be appropriated by the Town annually for deposit into the fund, the Town is authorized to and may deposit into the fund all monies received by it, from whatever source, as monetary gifts, grants or loans for open space purposes.

B. Fees to the Town collected in lieu of any requirement to provide open space; pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §§ 8-25 and 8-25b, and as authorized by the Zoning and Planning Commission; pursuant to the Town's Subdivision Regulations, (the 8-25b fees) shall be deposited into the fund.

C. The fund shall be in the custody of the Town Treasurer or other officer in charge of funds of the Town, and all or any part of the monies in the fund may, from time to time, be invested in any securities in which public funds may be lawfully invested. All income derived from such investments shall be placed into the fund and become a part thereof. The monies so invested shall at all times be subject to withdrawal from such investments for use as; hereinafter set forth.

D. No sums contained in the fund, including interest and dividends earned upon said sums, shall be transferred to any other account within the Town budget. No expenditures shall be made from the fund except in accordance with the provisions of this chapter.

C. If the Board of Selectmen approves a proposed Town acquisition or Town contribution, it shall forward the Conservation Commission's recommendation for the proposed Town acquisition or Town contribution to the Zoning and Planning Commission for a report pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 8-24, and to the Board of Finance.

D. Following action by the Board of Finance and the issuance of the Zoning and Planning Commission's report, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 8-24, final action on the proposed Town acquisition or Town contribution shall be taken by the Board of Selectmen or, if required by Town Charter, by the Town Meeting.

**§ 92-5. Required contract between Town and preservation entity.**

Prior to the receipt of funding pursuant to a Town contribution approved in accordance with § 92-4 above, a preservation entity shall enter into a contract with the Town, which contract shall provide, among other things, that the document to be recorded on the Colchester land records (e.g., deed, easement) that creates the conditions and restrictions relating to open space purposes that shall burden the subject property (the conditions/restrictions) shall provide that:

A. The conditions/restrictions shall be perpetual.

B. Such preservation entity shall comply with or enforce, as applicable, the conditions/restrictions.

C. The Town shall have the right, from time to time, to inspect the subject property for compliance with the conditions/restrictions.

D. In the event such preservation entity fails to comply with or enforce, as applicable, the conditions/restrictions, the Town shall have the right, but not the obligation, to comply with or enforce, as applicable, the conditions/restrictions. In the event the Town so complies with or enforces, as applicable, the conditions/restrictions, such preservation entity shall promptly upon its receipt of written notice from the Town, reimburse the Town for the Town's costs therefor.

E. For purposes of such contract and such document for the land records, references to such preservation entity shall include its successors and assigns.

They will not only visit our dog park but due to the dog parks convenient location they will also be likely to visit the many businesses and restaurants close by.

I've heard from many people from out of town that they enjoy visiting our dog park because they will also go to Harrys for lunch, Mackey's for dog food or other local businesses on their way through town.

Due to COVID we have been unable to fundraise for the last two years. We are anticipating that our 2022 fundraising will also be negatively impacted and will delay our ability to develop this needed project.

In 2018 we raised \$6500 with our Spring Bark and Pet Photos with Santa fundraisers. In 2019 that increased to \$7000. Our projected COVID fundraising losses for 2020, 2021, and 2022 is nearing the \$20,000 mark which will delay this planned project for several years.

**TOWN OF COLCHESTER**  
**BOARD OF SELECTMEN – BYLAWS**

**SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND AUTHORIZATION**

The name of the board shall be the 'Board of Selectmen of the Town of Colchester' (the Board). The purpose of the Board is to manage and oversee the internal operations of the Town. The Board of Selectmen oversees all Town Departments, Boards and Commissions and any office the Board fills by appointment.

The Board shall have all of the rights, powers and duties respectively conferred upon Board of Selectmen pursuant to the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, and Town of Colchester Charter, Section #401, #402, #403, #404 and #405.

**SECTION 2. OFFICE OF THE BOARD**

The office of the Board shall be the Colchester Town Hall where the Board records will be maintained. All correspondence shall be addressed to the Board c/o the Office of the First Selectman, 127 Norwich Avenue, Colchester, CT 06415. Copies of all agendas, minutes and resolutions of the Board shall be filed or recorded with the Office of the Town Clerk.

**SECTION 3. MEMBERSHIP**

- A. The Board shall consist of five (5) members elected in accordance with the provisions of the town Charter.
- B. All members of the Board shall participate fully in Board meetings and activities and shall have such duties as may from time to time be assigned by the Board.
- C. Resignation from the Board shall be in written form and transmitted to the Town Clerk who shall promptly forward same to the Board of Selectmen.

**SECTION 4. BOARD MEETINGS**

- A. The Board shall hold regular meetings at 7:00 p.m. on the first and third Thursday of every month, except when the Town Hall is closed due to public holiday or some other reason. In the event of such a scheduling conflict, an alternative meeting date may be scheduled by the Board. All meetings of the Board are open to the public, as required by the Connecticut General Statutes, unless otherwise specified.



- B. A quorum shall consist of three members.
- C. Minutes of the Board's meetings and hearings shall be kept and published in accordance with the Connecticut General Statutes.
- D. All mail addressed to the Board shall be presented by the First Selectman to the Board at its first meeting held after such mail has been delivered to the Board c/o The Office of the First Selectman. All mail shall be deemed 'received' when so presented.
- E. All regular and special meetings of the Board of Selectmen shall be audio recorded. Emergency meetings shall be audio recorded if possible. All recordings shall be made available to the public. The provisions of this section shall not apply to executive sessions.
- F. Citizens' Comments: The Board may permit any individual or group to address the Board concerning any subject that lies within its jurisdiction during the portion of any Board meetings so designated for such purpose. Citizens' Comments shall be subject to the following guidelines:
  - (1) If deemed necessary, in order to provide time for maximum citizen participation, the Board of Selectmen may establish a provision at a meeting to limit comments. In such a case, three (3) minutes will be allotted to each speaker at each warned citizen's comments. The Board may decide by a majority vote to extend the 3 minutes of time allotted.
  - (2) Speakers may provide written testimony or handouts to the Board, which will become part of the public meeting record.
  - (3) Speakers are only permitted to make presentations to the Board using PowerPoint, overhead projectors, or other electronic/digital programs with the prior approval of the First Selectman.
  - (4) All speakers must identify themselves by name and town of residence.
  - (5) The Board will not respond to comments made during Citizens' Comments, with the exception that the Chairperson only may respond if, in the discretion of the Chairperson, such comments require an immediate response.

## **SECTION 5. COMMITTEES AND COMMITTEE CHAIRMEN**

- A. From time to time, the Board of Selectmen may appoint such committees as may be deemed necessary or desirable. Any committee so appointed shall have the duties or responsibilities assigned to it at the time of appointment. The meetings of any committee so appointed are open to the public as required by the Connecticut General Statutes.
- B. At the time of appointment, the members of any committee appointed pursuant to this section shall elect one (1) of their members to serve as

Committee Chairman.

- C. The First Selectman and/or member of the Board of Selectmen may serve as an ex-officio member of any committee appointed in accordance with the section.
- D. For purposes of determining whether a committee may conduct business, a majority of committee members shall constitute a quorum.
- E. Minutes of all committee meetings and hearings shall be kept and published in accordance with the Connecticut General Statutes.
- F. All mail addressed to any committee shall be deemed addressed to the full Board and shall be treated in the same manner as set forth in Section 4, paragraph D.

## **SECTION 6. AMENDMENTS**

These bylaws may be amended from time to time as deemed necessary or desirable by the Board.

## **SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE**

These bylaws shall take effect immediately upon adoption by the Board and all photocopies or reproductions hereof shall clearly specify the 'Effective Date' on the cover page.
