American Ambulance is confident that we could be a much more fiscally responsible option for the Town of Colchester. While we appreciate how CHVFC may want to increase the level of service they provide, it doesn't always make sense fiscally. We understand that our proposal options may not be something that you're interested in, and that is fine, but we feel obligated to at least make you aware of your options through this discussion.

We currently conduct 911 responses in Norwich, Mashantucket, Franklin\*, Griswold and Ledyard at the EMT and Paramedic level. Our success in these towns are why we think we should meet. I look forward to hearing back from you soon.
