Notes:

- During the past month:
 - The office mailed motor vehicle and personal property bills on November 16th. Bills are due December 1 and become delinquent after January 2, 2023. In all the motor vehicle bills everyone should have received a notice of hours during the holiday. Please note:
 - Mail postmarked (US Postmark only) ON OR BEFORE January 2, 2023, will be considered as having been paid on time.
 - Anything left in the mailbox after 12:00pm NOON on December 30th will be deemed late.
 - MAIL put in the BLUE mailboxes all go straight to Hartford and MAY NOT be postmarked on time.
 - Finally, I would like to caution you about electronic payments that come directly from your bank. Most banking institutions have a disclaimer that is overlooked regarding the use of electronic payments for municipal taxes. When we receive these checks there is NO sign of a postmark on the envelope – therefore if we receive these checks after the due date they are deemed as being paid late and are subject to interest and penalties.
 - Real Estate Bills were mailed Friday December 2nd. Real Estate Bills are due January 1, 2023 and become delinquent after February 1, 2023
 - We are still working on the Motor Vehicle Supplemental Bills. These Bills will have a due date of January 1, 2023 and become delinquent after February 1, 2023
