



Project-Specific Highlights

- Titan estimates the projects will be approximately 1,000 kW in size, which will create approximately 1,250,000 kilowatt-hours per year.
- Titan shall issue an RFP on behalf of the Town of Colchester that will seek to identify a capable solar owner/operator to fully fund and maintain the systems.
- Colchester will be entitled to an annual lease payment for the landfill site and discounted power production from the array at the school.
- There is zero cost for the Town of Colchester to participate in this program.
- The Connecticut solar incentive program (Non-Residential Renewable Energy Solutions, or NRES) allows each developer an opportunity to bid into the program to secure project funding. There is a finite pool of money and Eversource selects the lowest bids first until the money is exhausted. The next solicitation will be September 2023.
- Titan will work in conjunction with the chosen vendor to submit the projects into the NRES program.
