Discussion & Possible Action on Budget:

Andreas Bisbikos made a motion as follows: A Motion to Freeze all spending on all BOE & Town Capital Projects in the proposed budget until Malloy numbers are known, not to include the middle school.

Rob clarified: Freeze on approved referendum (excluding last year): motion regarding start new projects 17-18 budget year.

Motion Clarified; A Motion to recommend to the BOS & BOE that there be no capital expense's be made until the final state budget 17-18 budget excludes WJMS or capital items being paid for from reserve.

Andrea Migliaccio made a motion as follows: A Motion to clarify that once Malloy cuts are determined that BOF protocol shall be to consider General Fund Balance and cuts before supplemental billing.
