  - a. Specific Items
    - Review of BOE Reductions Superintendent Burt discussed items that will be cut from the BOE budget proposal.
    - Revenue Update Changes made to the revenue discussed on information received from the Assessor and Tax Collector were discussed. R Tarlov mentioned that the State Finance committee had recommended reductions in ECS that would impact of revenue by 364,000 although PILOT money was increasing by 52,000. J Burt mentioned he had heard that there was talk of appropriating 7 million to hold towns harmless, meaning no reduction. R Coyle said that Senator Needleman said the same.
    - iii. Budget Calendar Review dates for Town Meeting and Referendum The possibility of delaying the referendum was discussed. Most All members are in favor of delaying for one week in the hopes of having received guidance on how grant funding may be spent and that some budget items could be covered by those funds. Town Clerk Gayle Furman went over some scenarios of date changes and how changes could impact the tax office as well as other financial implications.
