THIRD DOSES FOR IMMUNOCOMPROMISED INDIVIDUALS

Individuals who are moderately or severely immunocompromised may be eligible to receive a third dose of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine. For information about eligibility, visit the [CDC webpage](#).

BOOSTER SHOTS

For individuals who received a **Pfizer-BioNTech** or **Moderna** COVID-19 vaccine, the following groups are eligible for a booster shot at 6 months or more after their initial series:

- 65 years and older
- Age 18+ who live in [long-term care settings](#)
- Age 18+ who have [underlying medical conditions](#)
- Age 18+ who work or live in [high-risk settings](#)

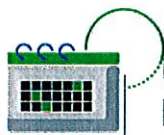
For individuals who got the **Johnson & Johnson** COVID-19 vaccine, booster shots are also recommended for those who are 18 and older and who were vaccinated two or more months ago.

Eligible individuals may choose which vaccine they receive as a booster dose.

Some people may have a preference for the vaccine type that they originally received, and others may prefer to get a different booster.

CDC's recommendations now allow for this type of mix and match dosing for booster shots.
