6. Butterfly Garden discussion and potential action: WJJMS students presented to the Committee a map outlining the locations they would like to do plantings. The plan consists of multiple small gardens with adaptive plantings for each area. The students have walked the site and discussed their plans with the Landscape Architect. Multiple departments at WJJMS are contributing to the gardens by building birdhouses and flowerbeds, as well as making flower pots. In the interest of the longevity of the project, students currently planning the Butterfly Garden will be presenting to 6th graders to recruit younger students. Once the Committee receives the list of items needed for the project they will approve the purchase. G. Kotait will reach out to the Landscaper that previously attended a meeting and offered his assistance with the garden.

# 7. Project Manager update and potential action:

- All additional furniture ordered was delivered.
- Trial casters on desks and chairs are working. Feet have been breaking off the chairs. The Committee
  would like the manufacturer to offer a discount on casters for the chairs due to the feet already being
  defective and needing to be replaced.
- J. Ruiz motioned to approve the addition of casters to all tables in the school in the amount of \$73,718
  as per quote from Red Thread, seconded by A. Tarnowski. Vote was unanimous. MOTION CARRIED.
- G. Kotait met with Custom Electric. If during the installation of new wiring for the Touchlt boards, RedThread comes in contact with any wiring installed by Custom Electric, Custom Electric's warranty will be voided.
- A. Tarnowski motioned to approve a purchase order in an amount up to \$103,897 to Red Thread to address wiring issues related to Touchlt screens, seconded by I. Malsbenden. Vote was unanimous.
